


Spring Garden College is proud to honor three outstanding individuals at the Commencement ceremony.

JOSEPH F. ENGELBERGER

Joseph F. Engelberger is the founder, President and Chief Executive Officer of Unimation, Inc., the nation's first and largest industrial robot manufacturer.

As a physics student at Columbia University, where he earned both his Bachelor's and Master's degrees, Mr. Engelberger was fascinated by science fiction writer Isaac Asimov's robot stories. A fascination that was to lead him to a pioneer role in bringing the robot industry to life.

The author of nu-



in the field of robotics, in 1980 he authored a widely used textbook entitled "ROBOTICS IN PRACTICE".

Public interest in robotics has resulted in numerous television appearances, including Johnny Carson's Show, the Merv Griffin Show, NBC Magazine and the McNeil-Lehrer Show. On Japanese television he is introduced as the "Father of Robotics."

Mr. Engelberger is generally considered to have been the driving influence in the creation of the industrial robot industry. The Robot Institute of America annually presents the Joseph F. Engleberger Award to "a person who has contributed outstandingly to the furtherance of the science and practice of robotics."

He has been honored by the Society of Manufacturing Engineers with their "Progress Award", and he has (Continued, next page)

Eva Gottscho is President and Chairman of the Board of Adolph Gottscho, Inc. of Union, N.J. She is a native of Chicago and was educated there and in New York City.

Head of the company since 1971, Mrs. Gottscho's dynamic leadership is responsible for her firm's position as the world's largest manufacturer of in-line imprinting and coding equipment.

An influential leader of the packaging industry, she serves as a member of the boards of the Packaging Education Foundation, The



Packaging Institute U.S.A. and the Packaging Machinery Manufacturers Institute.

Interested in industry-related higher education, Mrs. Gottscho serves on the Rutgers University advisory board for packaging science and engineering.

In the community her interest in health care is shown by her involvement as Board Chairman of the Ruth Gottscho Kidney Foundation, and as a member of various boards and committees administering the New Jersey Dialysis and Transplant Association, the Network Coordination Council, the New Jersey State Department of Health Chronic Renal Disease and the Department of Human Resources.

ALBERT SOFFA

Albert Soffa, chairman and co-founder of Kulicke and Soffa Industries, Inc., is a native of the Delaware Valley and was born November 2, 1920.

He is a graduate of Drexel Institute of Technology where he was awarded a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering in 1944 and Harvard University where he earned his Master's degree in the same field the following year.

Upon graduation he joined the General Electric Company as a test engineer and later

worked as a development engineer as part of a creative engineering program. His assignments took him to G.E. facilities in Lynn, Massachusetts, Philadelphia and Schenectady, N.Y.

In 1947 he returned to his native city as a patent and development engineer with the Proctor Electric Company and remained with them until 1951 when, with Frederick W. Kulicke, Jr., he founded the highly successful company that bears both of their names.

In addition to his many accomplishments in the business world Mr. Soffa has found time to serve his community, his faith and higher education.

He serves his alma mater, Drexel, as a member of the Board of Trustees and as a director of the University City Sciences Center. He is a director of the Solomon Schecter Day School, Camp Ramah in the Poconos, Philadelphia Friends of Boys Town Jerusalem and numerous other worthy organizations.
